



Great Dragon
Troupe/Tannaker/Tycoon
members who settled in
Britain 1869

- Kondo Fudekichi (b 1828, married Julia Knight in 1873, settled in Brighton)
- Kagami Omoto (b 1843) & Godayuu (b 1844) (settled in Australia after being based in Britain in 1870s)
- Ogawa Torakichi (b 1853, wire walker, married Isabella Hunter in 1872, moved to Germany 1885)

Great Dragon Troupe/Tannaker/Tycoon members who settled in Britain (1870)

- Kondo Yasokichi b 1853-55, juggler, block manipulator, married Emma Corbett 1876, d 1920)
- Kondo Torakichi b 1855-1858

 Condo and Son/Condos and little
 Miss Una. Connected to Ando
 troupe. Died 1925)

Great Dragon Troupe/Tannaker/Tycoon members who settled in Britain – 1878-1882

- Sekine Sho b 1832, wire walker, married Harriet Beddowes 1879 d 1911
- Sekine Ichitaro b 1857-60, balancing and block, married Nagahama Sua 1886, d 1899
- Sekine Kintaro b 1864-6, wire walker, married Lily Fitzgerald 1888, d 1901
